HUGH ROBBINS MYERS - born June 15, 1876, near Brandon, Miss., died March 22, 1924, Mobile, Ala., was buried in Bethel Cemetery, Rankin County, Miss. He attended Old Hebron and Florence High Schools and became a machinist. He was married July 8, 1903, to Mable Claire Smith, daughter of California (Callie) Augusta Bobbett Smith and Nathaniel Smith who was a native of Maine. The ceremony was performed in Brandon, by Mayor J.P. (Doc) Cole as the couple sat in their buggy in front of the court house where a crowd had gathered to witness the event. As a young man, Hugh worked for a time in Texas, in the oil fields, but at the time of his death he was employed by Naval American Veneer Company, Navco, Ala., a suburb of Mobile. Two children were born to this couple as follows:

I. Dora Maine Myers (Wimberly)(Golson) - born Sept. 19, 1907, has been a professional woman all of her adult life, currently employed by Health, Education and Welfare, of Jackson. Prior to this she was employed for a number of years by Knox Glass Bottling Works as accountant and bookkeeper, then became accountant and sec-treas. and member of board of directors for M.S. Short Construction Co., of Jackson. She is a member of the International Accountant's Society of Chicago, of American Society of Women's Accountants and of Capitol Business and Professional Women's Club, (treas. 1958-9). 

MARGIE MAE MYERS RIDDLE - born Nov. 28, 1878, died April 21, 1931, buried Bethel Cemetery, south of Brandon.

She attended the Myers School until she was grown, meanwhile taking organ lessons from Miss Nannie Fox who was a boarder in her parents' home. She was married April 20, 1896, at the age of 17 years, to Wm. Madison Riddle, son of T.J. Riddle and Sarah Frances Boucher Riddle. The ceremony was performed in the Myers home with the Rev. Wayne Sutton of Florence, officiating. They lived first in the Greenfield community and later in the Betel community where Billy engaged in farming, and cattle raising. Margie was a lifelong member of Bethel Church and served as organist and teacher for many years. Four children were born:

I. Ralph Caswell Riddle - born Dec. 16, 1897, Greenfield community, south of Brandon, is a retired farmer, saw-mill operator and cattle raiser, living in the Bethel community. 

He was educated in the Myers, Hebron and Florence Schools of Rankin County. A carpenter and cabinet Maker by trade, Roy was at one time employed by Holbrooks Manufacturing Co. of Jackson.

A small man in stature, measuring in his old age only five feet, he weighed about 125 pounds and wore a size 6 shoe. He had a musical talent and often sang and played the guitar and mandolin.

He was married twice. First to Byrt Payne of Water Valley, Miss. The ceremony was performed by Rev. A. Derrick, in Water Valley, Yalabushie County. He married second, Elsie Harris, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Billy Harris of the Bethel Community.

ALBERT BERRY MYERS - born Sept. 25, 1893, Myers community, south of Brandon, died June 1938, age 45 years, was buried in Bethel cemetery, Rankin County, with other members of the Myers family. Named for Brandon's two physicians, Dr. Albert G. McLaurin and Dr. J. T. Berry, he was always proud of his name. He attended the Myers School and later lived for a time in the home of his brother, Sam, and attended school in Brandon. He followed the family tradition and was a tiller of the soil. LAWRENCE LAFAYETTE MYERS - born December 2, 1858, the eleventh child of his parents in what is now the Bethel community, south of Brandon, on what later became the home of A. B. Stubblefield. Lawrence died May 17, 1921, Magee, Miss. of acute bronchitis following Spanish influenza and was buried in the Antioch Cemetery, of Rankin County. At the age of 12 years Lawrence was orphaned by the death of both parents who died on the same day in 1871. His foster home was with his aunt and uncle, Liza Tullos Dukes and Jim Dukes. He was married twice. First to Mary Anne Elizabeth Patrick (1862 - 1891), daughter of Ellis Patrick and Susan Hollon Patrick who were early settlers in Mississippi. Anne died at the age of 28 years when her youngest child was only six days old with only one child, Walter, surviving from this marriage. Lawrence married second, Ada Virginia Fortenberry (1874-1933) daughter of Bill and Evelyn Perry Fortenberry. The ceremony was performed Oct. 4, 1874, in Rock Bluff Church on Strong River.
